POSITIVE BEHAVIOR

STUDENTS WILL ALSO EARN POINTS FOR POSITIVE BEHAVIORS DEMONSTRATED IN THE CLASSROOM. -->

POSITIVE BEHAVIOR (CONT.)



IN OUR 3RD GRADE CLASS, WE WILL ALSO BE USING CLASSDOJO TO RECOGNIZE INDIVIDUAL POSITIVE BEHAVIORS. (SHOW DOJO)

IF STUDENTS ARE GIVEN MORE THAN ONE REMINDER TO MAKE A POSITIVE CHOICE IN THE CLASSROOM, POINTS WILL BE DEDUCTED FROM THEIR CLASSDOJO.

STUDENTS WILL MONITOR THEIR POINTS THROUGHOUT THE WEEK AND DETERMINE WHETHER THEY WANT TO "CASH" POINTS IN, OR SAVE THEM FOR SOMETHING SPECIAL! STUDENTS WILL HELP GENERATE A DOJO MENU -POSSIBLE WAYS TO "SPEND" : CHANGE AVATAR, LUNCH WITH TEACHER, BRAIN BREAK LEADER, SHOW AND TELL, FREE BOOK FROM SCHOLASTIC, ETC.

READING FOCUS

- READING WORKSHOP MODEL MINI LESSON, PURPOSEFUL PRACTICE, SHARE TIME
 - LAUNCHING OF READER'S ROUTINES/DAILY 5, FOLLOWING CHARACTERS INTO MEANING, MAIN IDEA AND TEXT STRUCTURE, BOOK CLUBS/CHARACTER STUDY, RESEARCH CLUBS
- GUIDED READING SMALL GROUP, DIFFERENTIATED INSTRUCTION
 - WHILE SOME STUDENTS ARE MEETING WITH THE TEACHER, OTHERS WILL HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO CHOOSE FROM A "LITERACY MENU" WHAT THEY WILL BE WORKING ON.
 - READER'S THEATER, WRITING, READING, RESEARCH (WHILE CREATING SOMETHING TO SHARE), BOOK REVIEW, WORD WORK, ETC.

- CONTINUE TO ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILD TO GET INTO THE ROUTINE OF READING 20 MINUTES EVERY NIGHT
- STUDENT READING LOG MORE INFORMATION COMING SOON

WRITING FOCUS

MATH

MATH WORKSHOP - MINI LESSON, PURPOSEFUL PRACTICE, SHARE TIME

- SIMILAR TO OUR GUIDED READING HOUR, STUDENTS WILL HAVE A "MATH MENU" TO CHOOSE MATH OPTIONS/ACTIVITIES TO EXPLORE, DISCOVER, CREATE, BUILD SKILLS, ETC. WHILE I WORK WITH GUIDED MATH GROUPS.
